Transitional Employment Assistance (TEA) Program

The TEA program emphasizes employment as the first step toward building a brighter future. Promoting economic and social well-being for families and assuring that all Arkansans have the opportunity to secure employment and increase their earning potential through on the job training, subsidized employment, work activities, education and job search assistance.

This federally funded program provides time limited cash assistance and supportive services to needy families with children while they attend school, complete job training and obtain employment. This program moves individuals back into the labor market in high demand occupations.

You Could be Eligible to Receive:

- Child Care Assistance
- Transportation Assistance
- Employment and Training Opportunities
- Monthly Cash Assistance

Qualifications:

- Have a Child under age 18 living in the home
- Limited or no monthly income
- Be an Arkansas resident
- Be a United States citizen or lawful alien

*(Additional eligibility requirements will be discussed upon application)
